## **Types of Assistance**

Early Childhood Tuition Assistance

**(ECTA)** provides tuition awards for one course per term while the individual is working in a NH licensed preschool program.

Granite Steps for Quality Tuition Assistance (GSQ) provides tuition awards for ECE courses for students working as preschool teachers, outof-school-time workers or elementary school paraprofessionals.

**CCSNH ECE Scholarships (ECE GAP)** 

can be provided to assist with ECE and General Education course costs for individuals enrolled in one of our ECE certificates or degree programs. These scholarships can be paired with our other tuition assistance programs resulting in little to no cost for your ECE education.
