This effort is funded by the NH Bureau of Child Development and Head Start Collaboration through Early Childhood Tuition Assistance (ECTA) and Preschool Development Grants (PDG).

Who Qualifies:

This grant is available to individuals working in NH licensed centers, including:

- Individuals working a minimum of 15 hours per week in an out-of-school time center
- Childcare teachers working a minimum of 20 hours per week
- Elementary school paraprofessionals working a minimum of 20 hours per week
- Childcare directors working a minimum of 30 hours per week

Tuition Assistance Details:

Applications will be reviewed as received.
Applications fill fast, so apply early. For 2024,
100% of tuition is covered for two ECE classes.
Students are responsible for all materials needed for the course and the \$92 registration fee.
